Topic: Archuleta Testimony (BCP, Specific Actions)

Re: GA-1T at page 8:1–3. Witness Archuleta states, “The Commission should view the Biennial Conservation Plan process as the primary method for establishing PSE’s targets and actions with respect to energy efficiency, including public engagement.”

- a. Please provide PSE’s Public Participation Plan for its Biennial Conservation Plan.
- b. Please explain how the Plan requested in subpart (a.) provides the same opportunities for community outreach and public input as PSE’s public participation plan for its CEIP.
- c. Please explain how PSE tracks and recovers costs for public participation associated with its BCP.

Response:

- a. Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) is currently developing a public participation plan that will be used to inform the 2024-2025 Biennial Conservation Plan (“BCP”). This plan will be reviewed and vetted by the Conservation Resource Advisory Group (“CRAG”) in 2023.
- b. The public participation plan being developed for the 2024-2025 BCP will be based on PSE’s public participation plan for its Clean Energy Implementation Plan (“CEIP”).
- c. Public participation costs associated with its BCP are tracked and recovered through the conservation rider.
