Dear Secretary Danner:

Enclosed please find substitute tariff pages 2, 6, 15, 16, 17, 19, 21, 22, 24, 25, 28, 29, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39 for the above-identified rate filing by Waste Management of Washington, Inc. d/b/a Waste Management Sno-King. These pages reflect a proposed settlement of this tariff filing that has been agreed to by Commission Staff and Company personnel, and which we expect to present to the Commissioners' for approval at the Open Meeting on May 27, 2010. Please do not re-docket.

As you are aware, this filing was initially submitted in December 2009. In the interim, the Commission ruled on a companion petition involving rule interpretation and application, the Company negotiated new collective bargaining agreements, the price of fuel and the state B & O tax rate changed. Those activities postponed the ability to finalize the proposed rates and, coupled with corrections made by Staff in auditing the filing, resulted in rates that are higher in most cases than those originally requested, and greater than the ones stated in the customer notices mailed in January.

Therefore, in transmitting these pages and pursuant to WAC 480-70-276, the Company also requests Less Than Statutory Notice for an effective date of June 1, 2010. We are also asking for a waiver of the customer notice rules in WAC 480-70-271. Instead, we seek approval to provide an insert in the next billing to customers, and to work with Commission Staff on the form and substance of that insert.
