Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits in connection with Docket No. UE-120277 the attached revised tariff sheets to replace the revised tariff sheets which were filed in a substitute filing on March 29, 2012, under the Company's Advice No. 2012-04. The attached revised tariff sheets reflect a change in the effective date from the substitute effective date of June 1, 2012 to July 3, 2012. The March 29, 2012 substitute filing reflected rates to pass through interest on the unamortized balance of U.S. Treasury Department grants for 2012 during the remaining seven months of 2012. Although the total amount of interest to be passed through does not change, changing the effective date necessitates changing rates to pass through the interest over six months rather than the seven months from the March 29, 2012 substitute filing. This increases the amount of credit that customers will receive and results in an increase in the overall reduction to bills. Work papers reflecting the revised rates will be forwarded to Commission Staff separately from this filing.
