TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 1, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 04, Approving Settlement; Classifying Respondent as Solid Waste Collection Company; Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 04) against Sean Smith (Company). Order 04 assessed a penalty of \$2,000 against the Company, \$1,500 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: 1) the Company refrain from operating as a solid waste collection carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate; and 2) the Company pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On August 17, 2020, the Commission entered Order 05, Granting Payment Arrangement Extension, which allowed the Company to complete payment of the portion of the penalty by February 2021. The Company paid the final installment on February 25, 2021.

On April 11, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a solid waste collection carrier without a certificate. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Sean Smith has complied with the conditions of Order 04. The \$1,500 suspended penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
