PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) appreciates the opportunity to respond to the Commission's Notice of Inquiry into reducing the administrative burden in support of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) ongoing inquiry into the adequacy of the current regulatory framework.

PacifiCorp's brief responses to Staff's comments are enclosed as Attachment A.

In addition to Staff's recommendations, PacifiCorp requests eliminating one additional reporting requirement, which is required by Order 12 in Docket UE-152253. Under Order 12, PacifiCorp is required to provide quarterly reports of the decoupling deferral amounts, and these reports are filed as an attachment to PacifiCorp's quarterly results of operations reports. Consistent with Staff's recommendation for Avista's decoupling quarterly reports, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that these reports be eliminated while maintaining the annual decoupling compliance filing submitted in Docket UE-152253 every June 15.
