Order 02 in the docket referenced above approved and adopted the settlement of the parties (Attachment A to that order) and authorized the Secretary of the Commission to accept by letter filings in compliance with that order. In Paragraphs 17 and 18 of the settlement, Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (“Waste Management”) agreed to work with Commission Staff and Kitsap County to develop a Company-wide Communication and Customer Outreach Plan for major service disruptions and a Kitsap County-specific Contingency Plan for maintaining adequate staffing for service in Commission-jurisdictional areas of the County. Waste Management is required to file both plans for Commission approval within 60 days after approval of the settlement.

In compliance with those requirements, Waste Management submits and requests approval of its attached “Communications and Customer Outreach Plan” and “Contingency Plan for WUTC-Jurisdictional Areas of Kitsap County, Washington.” Waste Management appreciates the cooperation of Commission Staff and Kitsap County in developing both plans. All parties have agreed to these plans.
