Reference Johnson workpapers, page 113. Please explain the basis for the 2006 projection as compared to 2004 actual. The provided workpapers do not provide any supporting detail.

RESPONSE:

Johnson workpaper P87 shows the revenue for Kaiser dynamic energy services (DES, load regulation). An old contract for Kaiser DES expired on January 22, 2005. A new contract began February 2005. Under the contract Avista supplies Kaiser with deviation energy that Kaiser purchases at market rates. A large portion of the revenue in 2004 was for the sale of deviation energy. The proforma does not include the sale of deviation energy because the revenues and expense nets to zero.
