Data Request No. 249 (Trimble testimony):

For each year from 1983 through the present, please provide a schedule showing the revenues received by Verizon Northwest Inc., or its predecessor Washington companies, from their directory affiliates. Please describe the type of revenue (e.g., publishing fees, subscriber listing fees), the dollar amount(s) of each type of revenue for that year, and the basis upon which the fees or revenues were calculated (e.g., cost plus fair return, retention ratio, market pricing). If these arrangements are reflected in affiliate agreements filed with the WUTC under RCW 80.16, please provide the date of filing and WUTC docket number if available.

RESPONSE:

Verizon objects to the wording of the question because it contains assumptions that are incorrect, in that it does not reflect the actual relationship between Verizon Northwest and the directory affiliate. Prior to 2000, Verizon Northwest did not receive revenue from the directory affiliate. Verizon Northwest performed billing and collection for the franchise directory revenue and remitted the directory affiliate share of this revenue to the affiliate per the Master Directory Publishing Agreement. The revenue data available for the years prior to 2000 is Verizon Northwest's share of the directory revenue per the referenced agreement.

Without waiver of the foregoing, attached is a schedule (Attachment 249) detailing directory revenue, FCC Account 5230, and billing and collection revenue, FCC account 5270, for the requested period.

Prior to year 2000, directory revenues were booked in accordance with the Master Directory Publishing Agreement and its predecessors (retention ratio). Starting in 2000, directory revenues are booked in accordance with the Directory Publishing and Information Provisioning Agreements filed on December 19, 2000 (market based on FCC orders).
