

4 **Commission Discussion and Decision.** The Washington Utilities and Transportation
Commission has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this
proceeding. Applicants ask the Commission to dismiss their Application without
prejudice in order to facilitate the Washington Commission's participation in a multi-
state process that will address certain issues related to this proceeding. No objection
to the dismissal has been voiced. Accordingly, it is consistent with the public interest
to dismiss the Application without prejudice.

ORDER

5 Applicants' request to dismiss the Application without prejudice is granted.
