Dear Mr. Rathbun,

Pursuant to Dockets PG-030080 and PG-030128 (King/Pierce County Settlement Agreement), Puget Sound Energy (PSE) is providing the semi-annual status report on the Isolated Facilities program for progress through June 30, 2007.

In the first half of 2007, PSE made progress on riser inspections, maps and records review, and riser follow-up inspections. PSE is on target to complete the riser inspections of both metered and unmetered services and EUFs in 2008 and the records review by February 1, 2009 consistent with the schedule included in Appendix I of the January 24, 2006 report.

In addition, the review to ensure all steel mains are included in the Bare Steel Replacement, Critical Bond, or Isolated Facilities Program was initiated. The stubs and casing reviews will begin in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2007. PSE will begin reporting more detailed progress of these additional phases of the program in the next report.
