6	A.	My name is Jon A. Piliaris. My business address is 355 110th Avenue NE,
7		Bellevue, WA 98004.
8	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
9	A.	I am employed by Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") as Director, Regulatory Affairs. I
10		have been employed by PSE since December 2008 and have been in my current
11		position since April 2018.
12	Q.	What are your duties as Director, Regulatory Affairs of PSE?
13	A.	I am responsible for federal, state and regional regulatory policy; cost of service
14		and pricing; tariffs; and overall regulatory affairs.
15	Q.	Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.
16	A.	I hold a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Pacific Lutheran University
17		and a Master of Arts degree in Economics from the University of Colorado,
18		Boulder. I have over 20 years of utility experience, primarily as a management
19		consultant for publicly-owned utilities that provide electric, natural gas, water
20		and/or wastewater services.

1	From January 1995 to March 2006, I was employed by Economic & Engineering
2	Service, Inc., later known as EES Consulting, Inc., a nationally recognized
3	engineering and management consulting firm. I provided consulting services on
4	behalf of EES Consulting in a wide variety of areas, including
5 6	• revenue requirements, cost of service, rate design, and related analyses;
7	• regulatory, litigation and arbitration support;
8 9	• representation within regional forums, such as proceedings at the Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA");
10 11	• electric utility resource planning, evaluation and acquisition;
12	• utility property valuation and acquisition;
13	• new utility formation;
14	• financial forecasting and feasibility analysis, and
15	• management reviews and performance benchmarking.
16	After leaving EES Consulting in March 2006 as its Managing Director of
