Please provide by zip code, disaggregated by electricity and/or natural gas service, the number of members of a “vulnerable population.” To the extent that “vulnerable population” is defined differently by different population attributes, provide these numbers for each definition of vulnerable population.

Response:

Please refer to Attachment A, which contains counts of customers within vulnerable populations, disaggregated by ZIP code and service type. Because Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") defined vulnerable populations using many sociodemographic and environmental data features, PSE disaggregated the population attributes by whether the customer resides in a census block group that is a highly impacted community, and whether that census block group's vulnerability label is high, medium, or low.

Each sheet presents customer counts for the corresponding fuel type. Within each sheet, each row represents a distinct ZIP code within PSE's service area. The columns indicate customers within that ZIP code that a) reside within a highly impacted community or not (HIC_YES / HIC_NO), and b) reside within a census block group with a vulnerability label of high/medium/low (VP_HIGH / VP_MEDIUM / VP_LOW).
