NW ENERGY COALITION'S PROPOSED PHASE 2 BUDGET

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.430, the Washington Interim Participatory Funding Agreement, and Washington Extended Interim Participatory Funding Agreement (Funding Agreements) approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission)¹, and Order 11 in this Docket, NW Energy Coalition (NWEC) respectfully submits its Proposed Budget for this phase of the proceeding, pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Funding Agreements. The Commission granted NWEC case certification in this matter on June 5, 2023, by Order 04, and approved NWEC's proposed budget by Order 05 on June 22, 2023. The Commission, by Order 11, established a deadline for those parties granted or requesting case certification who intend to seek funding to file their proposed budgets for this phase of the proceeding.

Statement of work for which funding is sought

2 NWEC has retained the Western Environmental Law Center (WELC) as outside counsel to represent it in this phase of the proceeding and is seeking a 2024 Fund Grant to partially offset legal fees. NWEC will continue to dedicate staff time to adjudicate PacifiCorp's Clean Energy Implementation Plan; including review of the Revised Clean Energy Implementation Plan; review, preparation, and filing of testimony and discovery; participation in settlement conferences; and participation at the hearing.

General areas to be investigated

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NWEC intends to review the Revised Clean Energy Implementation Plan's compliance with Commission rules and Orders in Docket UE-220376 (*Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company*) and its consistency with the Commission's guidance in Docket UE-210795 (*Puget Sound Energy's Clean Energy Implementation Plan*). In particular, NWEC intends to review how the Plan's proposed specific actions could impact issues related to renewable energy, customer-side resources, distribution system investment, energy efficiency, and affordability issues for low- and moderate-income customers, and how Pacific Power is prioritizing vulnerable populations and highly impacted communities.

Specific Funds / Available Funds

As stated in its May 25, 2023 Request for Case Certification and Notice of Intent to Request Fund Grant, and in its June 9, 2023 Proposed Budget NWEC requested a Fund Grant from the 2022 and 2023 Customer Representation Sub-Fund of the Customer Access Fund for PacifiCorp, which the Commission approved by Order 05, dated June 22, 2023. Section 4.2 of the Funding

NW Energy Coalition's Proposed Phase 2 Budget Agreements provide a Customer Representation Sub-Fund of \$200,000 for all parties for all PacifiCorp proceedings in 2024. At this time, NWEC does not have definitive information upon which to base an estimate of the amount of available funds in the account. NWEC is coordinating its request with the other case-certified parties as required under section 6.6 of the Funding Agreement.

Proposed Budget

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As reflected in Exhibit A, NWEC submits the following revised estimated budget for its previously approved requested 2023 Fund Grant in this matter, and an estimated budget for this phase of the proceeding from the 2024 Fund Grant. Through this revised budget, NWEC is not seeking additional funds, but is seeking to shift funds from its approved 2023 budget to its proposed 2024 budget and to reallocate those funds from staffing to legal fees, which are substantially below market rate.

2022 Fund Grant:	\$3,000
2023 Fund Grant:	\$ 12,000 \$7,000
2024 Fund Grant:	\$5,000

These amounts represent partial reimbursement of expenses for staff time and legal fees.
