Please provide a detailed explanation of the distinction between “non-resource topics” and “nonenergy benefits” as those two terms were used in developing the CEIP.

Response:

Puget Sound Energy uses the term “non-resource topics” on page 10, lines 2 and 6, and page 11, line 17, in Kara Durbin’s testimony, Exh. KKD-1T, in reference to the customer benefit indicators presented by the joint advocates that relate to bill assistance, disconnections and arrearages.

The term “nonenergy benefits” as used on page 2, lines 13-14 of Kara Durbin’s testimony, Exh. KKD-1T, is defined in the [Clean Energy Implementation Plan](#) glossary on page XV as, “a customer benefit indicator category required by the WUTC for named communities.”
