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5. The Petitioner has the following interest in this proceeding:

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The neighborhood in which is located the identified Seattle terminal for the applicant's proposed commercial ferry service that is the subject of these proceedings (Application B078946) has significant traffic problems. The City of Seattle generally supports and encourages the development of alternative modes of transportation within the City as a means of reducing automobile traffic and congestion and increasing the mobility of residents and others. Nevertheless, the City has concerns about whether and how Seattle Harbor Tours Limited Partnership intends to address any of the transportation problems and related demands upon the municipalities limited resources that may be generated by the commercial ferry operation that is the subject of these proceedings. Such problems and potential demands include but are not limited to increased vehicular traffic and an increased demand for parking, parking enforcement, police protection, signage, and other, related, municipal services.

6. The Petitioner will raise the following issues in this case:

- 1. Can the applicant demonstrate that:
 - (a) arrangements have been made with King County (METRO) and with other public or commercial transportation service providers regarding the delivery of transportation service between the proposed ferry landing point in Seattle and other transportation service hubs or access points?
 - (b) reasonable parking lot space is in the vicinity of the proposed Seattle terminal to lessen the potentially adverse impacts that are likely to result from increased vehicular
