On November 27, 2002, the Commission entered an order, docketed under TR-021463, approving a petition by the Cascade and Columbia River Railroad Company to upgrade train detection circuitry at a railroad-highway grade crossing. The order also approved the petitioner's request for Grade Crossing Protective Fund monies to pay \$1,750 towards this improvement (60% of the project cost).

In December of 2003, the Cascade and Columbia River Railroad Company notified Commission Staff that the project was complete, and provided a bill for reimbursement that totaled \$\$1,706.40. After notification, Ed Harper of Commission Staff verified that the work was completed according to the conditions set forth in the Order. It is therefore recommended that the Commission proceed with the specified disbursement from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund.
