- 1 On June 29, 2004, application GA-79288 was filed by Russell Vanderveen, d/b/a Vanderveen Family Transport, under the provisions of RCW 81.77, for temporary authority to operate Certificate No. TCG-158.

- 2 The Commission having considered the application and being fully advised in the premises finds that it would be in the public interest to grant the application.

ORDER

- 3 WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application is hereby granted, that upon complying with the laws and rules relating to solid waste collection companies, a certificate be issued to Russell Vanderveen, d/b/a Vanderveen Family Transport, authorizing the carrier to operate as a temporary solid waste collection company as follows:

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE consisting of Leachate from the Cedarville landfill to the City of Ferndale Waste Water Treatment Plant in Whatcom County under contract with Whatcom County.

- 4 This temporary certificate will end automatically, by operation of law and without further Commission action, when (1) the Commission enters an order approving withdrawal of Application No. GA-79289, or (2) the Commission enters an order granting Application No. GA-79289. If the Commission denies, dismisses, or grants less than all of Application No. GA-79289, this temporary permit will terminate on the last day for seeking judicial review of the Commission decision or, in the event of judicial review, on any later date that the reviewing court may order.
