
Dear Ms. Washburn,

We wish to protest the subject application of Gateway Shuttle Service, Inc. Applicant seeks door-to door passenger service in Clallam, Jefferson, Pierce, King and Kitsap Counties.

Specifically, the application states: " BETWEEN: Clallam and Jefferson Counties, and Seattle and Tacoma hospitals, Amtrak stations, Greyhound stations, and the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport with flag stops in Kitsap County with closed door service between Clallam and Jefferson Counties, and the indicated points in King and Pierce Counties".

We protest that portion of the application that specifies, "flag stops in Kitsap County" inasmuch as it duplicates our authority contained in Certificate 903 (copy enclosed). If the applicant will specify closed-door service between Kitsap County and Seattle Tacoma International Airport, this protest would be dropped.
