Subject: Brem-Air Disposal, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 19

Enclosed are revised pages 2, 22 and 25 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity credits for residential and multi-family customers receiving recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect a decrease of the current commodity credit from \$1.48 to \$1.41 per month for residential customers (5%) and an increase from \$0.21 per unit to \$0.36 per unit for multi-family customers (71%).

These changes are jointly due to the overall change in commodity values, tonnages and materials composition since our commodity credit adjustment on October 1, 2004. The proposed effective date of these tariff revisions is October 1, 2005.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Also enclosed for your consideration is a request for LSN treatment of these revised tariff pages, in order that these revised commodity price credits may become effective as of October 1, 2005. Customers will be notified of the change in their commodity credit adjustment on their next regularly scheduled billing. In addition, the county has been notified of these proposed tariff changes.
