[1] The ASGFR and ASGF2 credits from the Lifeline Assistance Program totaling \$8.51 apply in addition to the Tribal Lifeline credit. The FCC Lifeline Program consists of a monthly federal baseline support of \$5.84 (ASGFR). The Tribal Lifeline Credit is up to \$25.00, but no more than necessary to reduce the Tribal Lifeline rate to \$1.00. (C)

[2] The credit amount is calculated by adding the 1FR rate of \$12.50 plus the \$5.84 subscriber line charge together. An ASGFR and ASGF2 credit of \$8.51 is subtracted from the total and the remaining difference less \$1.00 which is the minimum Tribal Lifeline rate allowed, is the credit amount. For example: (\$12.50 + \$5.84 = \$18.34 - \$8.51 = \$9.83 - \$1.00) = \$8.83 credit. (C)
