On June 15, 2009, the city of Richland (City or Petitioner) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), a petition seeking approval to reconstruct a railroad-highway grade crossing and modify existing warning devices. The proposed improvement included a roundabout to provide traffic control at the intersection/grade crossing. The crossing is identified as USDOT #310397T and is located at the intersection of Steptoe Street and the Port of Benton's tracks in the city of Richland, Benton County. An order was issued by the Commission, Docket TR-090912 Order 01.

The City of Richland, respectfully, withdraws this petition. This petition is withdrawn in favor of a future petition with intersection traffic signalization instead of a roundabout. I appreciate the Commission's time and consideration with respect to this matter.
