Ecology is pleased to approve Ferry County's Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, submitted for final review and consideration on November 16, 2010.

Planning efforts by their very nature force a hard look at difficult issues. Plans are documents that draw roadmaps that set direction for future activities.
