1 On March 22, 2012, JJ Limousine Services, Inc., (JJ Limousine Services, Inc.), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to provide charter and excursion carrier service in the state of Washington under RCW 81.70. JJ Limousine Services, Inc.’s application is incomplete as it lacks proper registrations with other state agencies, a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E), and a CVSA safety inspection of the vehicles.

2 On March 22, April 26, and May 29, 2012, the Commission sent JJ Limousine Services, Inc., notices to comply with the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30. JJ Limousine Services, Inc., has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.

3 The application filed by JJ Limousine Services, Inc., in Docket TE-120383, should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30.

ORDER

4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by JJ Limousine Services, Inc., on March 22, 2012, in Docket TE-120383 for charter and party excursion carrier service is dismissed.

5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(5)(f).
