
As you are aware, on July 11, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Palouse River & Coulee City Railroad in the amount of \$2,100 for violation of WAC 480-62-300, which requires railroad companies to file annual reports with the Commission by May 1 each year. Palouse River & Coulee City Railroad filed its annual report for 2011 on May 31, 2012, which is 21 business days past the deadline, and has incurred a penalty of \$2,100. The Commission sent Palouse River & Coulee City Railroad a Second Notice on August 15, 2012, and a Final Notice on September 19, 2012.

The Commission has not received the \$2,100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,100 balance.
