
As you are aware, on July 24, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Grayport Transfer & Storage Co., Inc. in the amount of \$2,100 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Grayport Transfer & Storage Co., Inc. failed to file its annual report for 2011 and has incurred a penalty of \$2,100. The Commission sent Grayport Transfer & Storage Co., Inc. a Second Notice on August 29, 2012, and a Final Notice on October 3, 2012.

The Commission has not received the \$2,100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,100 balance.
