RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-120925

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 24, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Help-U-Move Inc. in the amount of \$650 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Help-U-Move Inc. filed its annual report for 2011 on May 18, 2012, which is 13 business days past the deadline of May 1, and has incurred a penalty of \$325. Help-U-Move also received penalties for failing to file annual reports by the deadline in 2008 for an additional \$325. The Commission sent Help-U-Move Inc. a Second Notice on August 29, 2012, and a Final Notice on October 3, 2012, for the total penalty of \$650.

The Commission has not received the \$650 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$650 balance.
