Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on August 1, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. (Legacy) in the amount of \$800 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Legacy filed its 2012 annual report on May 23, 2013, 16 days past due, and has incurred a penalty of \$800. The Commission sent Legacy a Second Notice on September 11, 2013, and a Final Notice on October 16, 2013.

The Commission has not received the \$800 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$800 balance.
