- On December 13, 2013, Mike and Glenda Beck (Complainants) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a complaint against Cristalina, LLC (Cristalina). The complaint alleges that on November 26, 2013, Cristalina shut off water service to the Complainants' home due to non-payment of disputed water bills incurred between 2007 and 2010. A more detailed account of the dispute is referenced in the complaint, which is available for inspection at the Commission's office located at Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington, and on the Commission's website at www.utc.wa.gov/132268.
- 2 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.479 and WAC 480-07-620, the Commission initiates this emergency proceeding to prevent or avoid immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare.
- STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 80, and has legal authority to regulate the rates, services, and practices of water companies providing service with the state of Washington. The statutes that apply to this matter include RCW 80.01, RCW 80.04, and RCW 80.28 relating to rates, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.01.060, RCW 80.04.020, RCW 80.04.110, RCW 80.04.380, RCW 80.04.405, RCW 80.28.020 and RCW 80.28.050. The rules that apply to this matter include those within WAC 480-07 and WAC 480-110. Also applicable are RCW 34.05.479 and WAC 480-07-620, emergency adjudicative proceedings.

The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.

- The Commission finds there is good cause to hear this matter on shortened notice. See WAC 480-07-440(1)(a).
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a hearing in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on December 23, 2013, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
- All parties must be prepared to present witnesses and supporting documentary evidence at the time of the hearing. Parties presenting documentary exhibits should bring an original and seven (7) copies of each exhibit.
- 8 Any party or witness in need of an interpreter or other assistance should fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission.
- 9 THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the hearing set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.
