RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UW-140844

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on May 28, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Harrison Water Company Kiona LLC in the amount of \$100 for violation of WAC 480-110-505, which requires water companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Harrison Water Company filed its annual report for 2013 on May 2, one business day past the deadline of May 1, resulting in a penalty of \$100. The Commission sent Harrison Water Company a Second Notice on June 25, 2014, and a Final Notice on July 26, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$100 balance.
