RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Norlight, Inc.

Staff's Request to Rescind Penalty Assessment Docket UT-140906

Dear Mr. King:

On June 2, 2014, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,000 Penalty Assessment in Docket UT-140906 against Norlight, Inc. for 10 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-120-382, which requires telecommunications companies to furnish annual reports to the commission no later than May 1 each year.

The company submitted the annual report via E-Filing 503 which was received by the commission on April 30, 2014. Research indicates a clerical error resulted in the company being included on the companies in violation listing. As Norlight, Inc. timely filed its 2013 annual report on April 30, 2014, staff recommends that the assessed penalty be withdrawn and the docket closed.
