RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UT-140917

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 3, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Telecare in the amount of \$1,000 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report and pay regulatory fees each year by May 1. Telecare failed to file its 2013 annual report and pay its 2014 regulatory fees and has incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission sent Telecare a Final Notice on October 9, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$1,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
