RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-140982

Dear Mr. Pettinger:

As you are aware, on June 6, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against you in the amount of \$1,000 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report and pay regulatory fees each year by May 1. You failed to file your annual report for 2013 or pay your 2014 regulatory fees and have incurred a penalty of \$1,000. You have made two payments totaling \$500 and a balance of \$500 remains due and owing. The Commission sent you a Final Notice on July 26, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$500 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$500 balance.
