
Dear Mr. King:

The purpose of this letter is to advise the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission (“Commission”) of a change in classification resulting from the transfer of control of World Communications, Inc. (“WCI”), a Class B company, to Integra Telecom Holdings, Inc. (“Integra” and together with WCI, the “Parties”), a Class A company, on October 1, 2014.

On July 19, 2014, the Parties filed a letter to advise the Commission of the transfer of control, and to ensure the continuing accuracy of the Commission’s records (see Docket No. UT-141492). The Parties now file this letter pursuant to WAC 480-120-034, to notify the commission secretary that, as a wholly-owned subsidiary of Integra, the classification of WCI has changed from Class B to Class A. Consequently, WCI is now subject to the service quality reporting requirements of WAC 480-120-439, and Integra’s monthly service quality report will incorporate WCI data as of October 1, 2014.
