RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Crown Moving Company, Inc.

Commission Staff's Response to Application for Mitigation of Penalties TV-150900

Dear Mr. King:

On May 27, 2015, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,000 Penalty Assessment in Docket TV-150900 against Crown Moving Company, Inc. for 10 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-15-480), which requires household goods carrier companies to furnish annual reports to the commission no later than May 1 each year.

On June 1, 2015, America's Elite, Inc. wrote the commission requesting mitigation of penalties. In its mitigation request, Crown Moving Company, Inc. does not dispute the violation occurred. The company states, "I have attached an updated annual report that includes all of the requested information. Historically, we have not provided this information. We have noted "statistics not available" and not been penalized. We will provide going forward".

It is the company's responsibility to ensure that the regulatory fee is paid and the annual report is filed by the May 1 deadline. On February 27, 2015, Annual Report packets were mailed to all regulated household goods companies. The instructions for annual report completion page of the annual report informed the regulated company that it must complete the annual report form, pay the regulatory fees, and return the materials by May 1, 2015, to avoid enforcement action.

On May 5, 2015, Crown Moving Company, Inc. filed an incomplete 2014 annual report and paid the required regulatory fees. On June 1, 2015, the company filed the required information and the report was considred complete.

The mileage and household goods moves information omitted from Schedule 1 of the 2014 report, which resulted in the report being incomplete, was also omitted from the 2013 report. However, commission staff contacted the company regarding the 2013 report requiring the information be submitted on May 7, 2014 via email. The company complied on May 9, 2014 via email. During the 2013 reporting year, no penalty was assessed as the commission had previously accepted Crown Moving Company's report without the mileage data.

Crown Moving Company, Inc. previously missed the deadline for filing its annual report and paying its regulatory fees for the 2012 annual report year. Due to the prior violation of WAC 480-15-480 and prior notification of required mileage and household goods moves data, staff does not support any mitigation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANNUAL REPORT COMPLETION

Commission Authority

The purpose of this form is to collect financial and operational information from household goods companies regulated by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). The commission's authority for requiring this report is found in RCW 81.04.080. This report is a non-confidential public use form.

Certification

The Annual Report Certification must be signed by an authorized officer, partner or owner.

Regulatory Fees

Regulatory fees are set by commission order A-140166.

Deadlines and Penalties

All household goods companies regulated by the UTC are required to complete this form, including all schedules. Failure to complete all schedules will result in the report being considered incomplete and subject to penalties. Completed forms and regulatory fee payments must be received by the UTC no later than *May 1, 2014*. Failure to file the annual report by the above deadline will result in a financial penalty of \$100 for each business day after May 1. Failure to pay the regulatory fees by the above deadline will result in a 2 percent penalty on the amount due and a 1 percent monthly interest charge on the unpaid balance.

Extension Requests

You may file a written request for an extension to file the completed annual report; however, the commission will not extend the deadline for paying regulatory fees. Any extension request must be filed with the commission by April 17, 2014, and must state a valid reason for why the extension is needed and identify a specific date which the report will be filed with the commission. The commission will notify you by April 24 whether your request is approved or denied. Even if your request is approved, you will still be liable for penalties and interest payments if you fall to pay your regulatory fees by May 1. No longer operating in Washington

You may cancel your registration or permit by using the Voluntary Cancellation Form available at: http://www.utc.wa.gov/regulatedIndustries/transportation/householdGoods/Pages/default.aspx
However, if your company operated in Washington at any time during the 2013 calendar year, you must pay regulatory fees and file a closing annual report based on the months of operation during 2013.

Confidential Status

Household goods companies are not permitted to file annual report documents as confidential. If a company regulated under RCW Title 81 submits its annual report or fee sheet as confidential, the commission will reject that submission and will not consider the report to be filed until the date the company submits the report and all required documents and information without any designation of confidentiality. If that date is after May 1, the company will be subject to the penalties described above. The commission will not disclose credit card information, if included, on the Payment Information Page or via online filing.
