Dear Mr. Aguilar:

As you are aware, on June 8, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Juan Aguilar d/b/a J C Limousine Service in the amount of \$100 for violation of WAC 480-30-071, which requires charter and excursion carriers to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. On May 4, 2015 Juan Aguilar d/b/a J C Limousine Service filed its 2014 annual report and paid its 2015 regulatory fee, which is one business day late, and has incurred a penalty of \$100. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 13, 2015, indicating that the balance of \$100 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$100 balance.
