Iliad Water Services, Inc. is filing with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to increase usage rates for customers on the Marbello Water System.

The change in rates will in theory produce an estimated \$63,460.00 in additional revenue. This represents 90.38 percent increase in the company's annual revenue. The reason for the increase is to pass through the increase in usage rates from the City of Monroe. If approved, the rates will be effective August 1, 2016.

The Company purchases all water used by customers on the Marbello Water System from the City of Monroe. Earlier this year, the City of Monroe increased their effective rate for water from just over \$4.54 per 100 cubic feet to \$8.34 per 100 cubic feet. This is an increase of 84 percent.

The increase in your rates is as follows:
