Dear Mr. Moseley:

As you are aware, on December 15, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against You Got It Movers in the amount of \$1,500 for violations of WAC 480-15-560, Equipment Safety, and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety. As of December 30, 2016, You Got It Movers did not pay the penalty imposed by the Commission. The Commission sent You Got It Movers a Final Notice dated February 16, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$1,500 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$1,500 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,500 balance.
