The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has completed its review of the revised cost assessment questionnaire for the preliminary draft of the Thurston County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan), submitted July 31, 2017.

The cost assessment questionnaire in the 2018-2023 Plan proposes no changes in tip fees at the transfer stations located in Thurston County. As a result, there will be no rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Thurston County at this time. Staff notes that Thurston County is currently conducting a comprehensive study of the solid waste infrastructure, but the outcome is currently unknown and the county plans to amend the Thurston County Solid Waste Management Plan if tipping fees are increased to fund capital improvements resulting from the study.
