Dear Mr. King,

On Friday, September 8, 2017, the Commission served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Charter and Excursion Carrier and/or Auto Transportation Certificate and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on 14 charter and excursion and/or auto transportation companies. The Notice informed each company that the Commission intends to cancel its authority unless, within 30 days, the company comes into compliance with applicable law by (1) submitting the delinquent annual report and/or paying the required regulatory fee or (2) requesting a hearing to demonstrate why the company's authority should not be canceled.

The thirty days elapsed on October 8, 2017. As of Wednesday, October 11, 2017, the following companies came into compliance with annual report and regulatory fee submission requirements:
