Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff No. 3 of Torre Refuse & Recycling d/b/a Sunshine Disposal & Recycling (G-260) in Spokane County. The purpose of the County of of the Count tate Of WASH.
AND TRANSP. Sunshine Disposal & Recycling (G-260) in Spokane County. The purpose of this filing is to update the annual recycle commodity credit, and to reflect the adjusted disposal rate at the City of Spokane Waste to Energy Facility.

If approved, these proposed changes will reduce revenue approximately \$11,700 annually or about 0.3% on tariff revenue.

We request waiver of WAC 480-70-351 which requires a twelve month historical period to estimate the revenue for the next twelve months. Rates as proposed reflect a five month average. Due to international market forces, the value of co-mingled material at the local MRF has swung from a positive value to a substantially negative cost in recent We believe co-mingled material will remain at a negative value for the months. foreseeable future.
