For a company seeking to avoid further enforcement action by ceasing unpermitted operations and leaving the industry, you must bring sufficient documentation or records to demonstrate closure of your unpermitted business. For example, those records might include documentation from (1) the Secretary of State's office for your business; (2) the Department of Licensing for your business license; (3) your internet service provider (or equivalent) showing cancellation of a website or email account; (4) your telephone provider showing cancellation of your corporate telephone number; (5) proof of cancellation of your company advertising; and (6) sales receipts for any company equipment sold in the process of shutting down and closing.

In lieu of producing the subpoenaed documents at the proceeding by mailing them together with your certification that the items produced are true and correct copies of the subpoenaed documents to:
