Dear Mr. Santos,

Ednetics, Inc. ("Ednetics") and Fatbeam, LLC ("Fatbeam") are affiliates. As our companies have grown, we find we are each selling some of the same products. We each provide transport in the form of point-to-point circuits to deliver Internet services and Wide Area Networks. In effect, we are competing with one another. Realigning the two companies to work better together creates an equally beneficial business relationship and provides better service to our Customers.

On or about July 1, 2018, Ednetics will transition their Internet and Wide Area Network private line customers to Fatbeam. The transition will be seamless to our customers on several fronts. The Ednetics assets used to provide these services are a part of the transition and will remain in place as they are today. Customers should experience no disruption of services as what little behind the scenes work is necessary will be accomplished during normal after hour's maintenance windows. Ednetics account managers will still maintain the relationship they have with their customers and customers will still contact them for on-going account activity.
