Dear Mr. Johnson:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 9, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity price adjustment (CPA).

For Pierce County Refuse the CPA will decrease from a credit of \$.24 to a debit of \$2.56 (1,166%) per residential customer per month. This change affects approximately 52,000 customers in Pierce County.

For residential customers on Joint Base Lewis- McChord, also known as "EQR," the CPA will decrease from a credit of \$.35 to a debit of \$2.32 (762%) per unit per month. This change affects approximately 4,900 customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

This filing was previously filed on July 18, 2018, and issued TG-180641. That filing was subsequently withdrawn so a 30-day customer notice could be sent to each customer, at the Commission's request. We now respectfully request this filing go into effect on October, 1, 2018 with less than statutory notice, under the provisions of WAC 480-70-276.

Due to the volatility in the recycling commodity markets we are hereby requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351(2). The calculation uses the most recent six-month historical period to estimate the recycling commodity revenue/commodity price adjustment. Further, we request the pay-back period to be five months, expiring February 28, 2019, due to delays created complying with the customer notification requirement.
