Dear Mr. Johnson:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and WAC 480-80-101 and WAC 480-80-105(1)(c), please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”):

- 6th Revision of Sheet No. 140-B Schedule 140 Property Tax Tracker (Continued)**
- Original Sheet No. 120-A.1 Schedule 120 Electricity Conservation Service Rider (Continued)**
- 3rd Revision of Sheet No. 141-D Schedule 141 Expedited Rate Filing Rate Adjustment (Continued)**

The purpose of this filing is to prepare for Microsoft’s anticipated migration from Schedule 40 to a special contract on April 1, 2019 through tariff revisions to Schedule 140 Property Tax Tracker, Schedule 120 Electricity Conservation Service Rider and Schedule 141 Expedited Rate Filing Rate Adjustment.

Proposed revisions clarify the charges applicable to the special contract as well as differentiate rates for high, primary and secondary voltages. Schedule 40 rates will apply to all special contract voltages under Schedule 140 until the conclusion of PSE’s next general rate case. For special contract rates under Schedule 120, Schedule 40 rates will apply to primary and secondary voltages and Schedule 49 High Voltage General Service rates will apply to high voltage. Special contract rates are consistent between all voltages under Schedule 141.

To allow for Microsoft’s anticipated April 1, 2019 commencement of service on a special contract, PSE respectfully requests that the Commission allow these tariff changes to become effective on April 1, 2019 with less than statutory notice (“LSN”). The information required by WAC 480-80-122 Tariff Changes with Less Than Statutory Notice, is contained in the attached LSN form.
