Subject: Waste Management of Spokane, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 18

Enclosed are revised pages 2 and to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of this filing is to correct a clerical error that was previously not discovered by either the company or the Staff. The correction of this clerical error requires revising the rebate of \$1.04/mo. per customer to \$0.77/mo. per customer. Staff agrees with the correction of this error. Accordingly, we are requesting that the proposed effective date of these tariff revisions be November 13, 2019.

In order to correct this error as quickly as possible we are requesting that the 45-day notice requirement to the commission be waived and allow the new rebate to go into effect on less than statutory notice (LSN).

In addition to revised tariff pages, enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers and the LSN. Customers will be notified of the change in their commodity credit adjustment on their next regularly scheduled billing after the approval of the Commission.
