Dear Mr. Pearson;

Rocket Transportation is writing this appeal to eliminate or reduce penalty assessments: TC-190879 and we appreciate for your time and consideration of this matter.

Rocket fully admits that the lapses in Driver DOT Renewals, the lack of filing of the documents in their respective files, and inconsistent vehicle inspections are in violation of WAC 480-50-221.

Although it does not excuse the violations, we ask that you take into account the additional challenges that Rocket has worked through since our last audit. As I mentioned two years ago, "Finding additional management willing to work at such a low compensation level (the same \$15/hour that I make as Owner) does not come with full competency." The Operations Manager and Dispatcher both departed Rocket soon after the last audit finding the level of responsibility too high for the compensation received. As a result, the safety training received by them at the audit was also lost.

Rocket did not give up and continued forward with Agents and Drivers stepping outside of their duties in an attempt to maintain safety while serving our clients. In addition we have learned that processes are weak if someone isn't responsible to ensure action. We now have: a strong Dispatcher who maintains personnel files with my assistance; a new Vehicle Maintenance Manager whose sole job at Rocket is Vehicles; and a new DVIR that will make Safety just standard practice.

We are distressed and concerned that the document expiration and filings were overlooked and assure you that this was not as we intended nor reflects our path forward. We will not stop here but will continue to make changes in daily operations until a Perfect Safety Compliance is achieved at every audit.
