Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”).

The purpose of this filing is: (1) to comply with Order No. 8 Rejecting Tariff Sheets, Authorizing And Requiring Compliance Filing in Docket Nos. UE-111048 and UG-111049 (the “Order”) and the Multiparty Settlement Stipulation Re: Electric Rate Spread, Electric Rate Design And Renewable Energy Credit Tracker (“Settlement Stipulation”) approved by the Order to make a filing to reset rates effective January 1, 2020; and (2) to reflect the impacts of Order No. 10 Granting Motion to Amend Order 08 (“Order 10”) in Dockets UE-111048 and UG-111049 (consolidated) when resetting rates, to become effective January 1, 2020.

The total amount of Renewable Energy Credit (“REC”) sales’ net proceeds to be passed through to customers in 2020 is \$1,247,712. Combined with interest, the true-up of the rate for the prior period and revenue sensitive items totaling \$383,159, the revenue requirement for the credit increased by \$148,172 and results in an overall rate decrease of 0.01 percent.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of November 27, 2019, and an effective date of January 1, 2020. Posting of proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is

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being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site coincident with the date of this transmittal letter in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1). PSE will also provide customers a published notice of the change since a published notice is required for other rates that also become effective on January 1, 2020.
