Dear Mr. Johnson:

On September 22, 2020, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or “the Company”), filed proposed revisions to its electric tariff WN U-28, Schedule 70, Rules and Regulations. These modifications are intended to incorporate the amendments made to WAC 480-100 via General Order R-600 in Docket No. U-180525, the rulemaking “Relating to Consumer Protection in Response to Investor-owned Utility Deployment of Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI)”, as well as to remedy several issues with overall verbiage and organization of the tariff, and to update outdated provisions and Company business processes.

In its original filing, Avista requested that the proposed tariff modifications become effective for service on November 1, 2020. After subsequent conversations with Commission Staff, the Company hereby respectfully requests to extend its requested effective date to December 1, 2020.
