Dear Mr. Johnson:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 8, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity credit adjustment. Tariff pages 1, 21 and 24 are affected by this change.

The residential adjustment will increase from a debit of \$1.95 to a debit of \$2.04, an increase of \$.09, (4.6%) per customer, per month. There are approximately 61,300 customers affected by this change. The multi-family adjustment will decrease from a debit of \$.77 to a debit of \$.73, a decrease of \$.04 (5.2%) per customer, per month. There are approximately 12,300 customers affected by this change. Pacific Disposal, Butlers Cove Refuse Service and Rural Garbage Service do not currently participate in any county revenue share program.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity credit will go into effect on January 1, 2021. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revised rates.
