RE: 2022 Disposal Increase - G-12 Tariff Number 11 for Rabanco Ltd (dba Rabanco Companies, Eastside Disposal, and Rabanco Connections).

Executive Director and Secretary Amanda Maxwell:

Please find attached revised tariff pages associated with tariff revisions for G-12 Tariff Number 11 for Rabanco Ltd (dba Rabanco Companies, Eastside Disposal, and Rabanco Connections).

This proposed change in the tariff reflects the impact of the increase of King County's disposal rate per ton from \$140.82 to 154.02 effective January 1, 2022.

If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement increase reflected in this filing would approximate 3.77% or \$136,293.17 for Commercial and Residential customers. The disposal increase for roll-off customers only impacts pass through disposal revenue so there is no change to haul rates for these customers.

Notification of a rate increase related to the King County disposal fee increase will be included in the first invoice mailed after WUTC approval of the proposed rates.

Finally, we would now also request that the Commission, under WAC 480-07-370, grant a waiver to the general rate case work paper filing requirements in WAC 480-07-520 (4.)
